In connection with the Application of Floridian Natural Gas Storage Company, LLC ("FGS") for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct, own and operate a new natural gas storage facility filed on October 31, 2007 in the above-referenced docket (the "Application"), FGS hereby files the following supplemental information.

In the Application, FGS stated that it expected that the primary source of water for hydrostatic testing of the tanks and pipelines would be the FPL Martin Plant cooling ponds, with an alternate source of water available from the St. Lucie Canal. Subsequent to filing the Application, FGS has further developed this portion of the Project and has reversed its order of preference for the source of the hydrostatic test water. At present, FGS considers the St. Lucie Canal the primary source of water for the hydrostatic testing, and the FPL Martin Plant cooling ponds as a potential alternate source of water. This reversed preference has transpired due to further discussions with landowners and agency representatives, as well as field visits to the location of the temporary facilities for the transmission of the water for hydrostatic testing.

FGS is in the process of evaluating details on the engineering and environmental impacts of running a temporary line to the St. Lucie Canal, and will provide this additional information under separate cover in the near future.
